

- 1) **Are you requesting any specific items or deliverables other than a cover letter and SOQ?** No
- 2) **Is a copy of the Phase I publically available or will it be made available to the selected consultant?** Yes publically available and yes the consultant will be given a copy of all available information associated with the site.
- 3) **How many hard copies of the SOQ would you like or is an emailed electronic version acceptable?** One email is acceptable and is preferred.
- 4) **Are there any schedule requirements to meet funding deadlines (e.g., completion of Task 1 by May 2017)?** A complete and final report must be completed by April 1, 2017 and all construction and field work must be completed by March 1, 2017
- 5) **Since there are Hydrocarbons and solvents identified for sampling in surface water, groundwater, and soils and within the Sundance and Daychild Creeks potentially impacted?**  
Sundance creek is east of Compound and Daychild Creek runs south of the compound into Sundance creek.
- 6) **Is the site somewhere near the Rocky Boy High School?** Yes, approximately 1/8 of a mile. The site is the BIA/CCT Roads Compound.
- 7) **Does a source area of contaminated soils exist?** (not LNAPL/DNAPL source areas
- 8) **Is the contamination from a mechanic shop or fueling station type facility?** Yes, the facilities included a Bureau of Indians Affair roads department garage maintenance shop, Roads Lean-to and some fueling sites over approximately 60 years.
